

State Funding Available for Local Clean and Shared Mobility Projects in California

Do you want to improve your community's health, air quality and economic opportunities?

The California Air Resources Board, through its program administrator CALSTART, is investing \$20 million in clean mobility projects, such as bike share, car share and van pools.

The Clean Mobility Options Voucher Pilot is part of California Climate Investments, a statewide initiative that puts billions of Cap-and-Trade dollars to work reducing greenhouse gas emissions, strengthening the economy, and improving public health and the environment – particularly in disadvantaged communities.

The Voucher Pilot is available to disadvantaged and low-income communities in California, including some Tribal and affordable housing communities, to increase access to safe, reliable, convenient, and affordable transportation options.

Funding will be available in early 2020.
